***Regarding Today's Florida Supreme Court Oral Arguments on the
Signature Revocation Law***

“A basic tenet of our democratic system is the right to have your voice heard. Citizens have the ability to affect change by coming together to petition for ballot initiatives. However, this process can only be fully complete, and fully democratic, when a mechanism for signature revocation is a part of this process. If you mistakenly sign a petition, are misled into signing a petition, or simply change your mind, then you should have the opportunity to remove your name from that petition. We hope and trust the Supreme Court will agree and uphold the 2007 signature revocation law.”
